

APJCC Swim Team Family Code of Conduct Agreement

As we move forward in these challenging times, our community's health and safety is our priority. We want to emphasize your role in helping to protect your child's teammates, our staff and our families' vulnerable members. We ask you to sign the bottom of this document as an indication that you agree to abide by the following:

General Team Information:

- All Swimmers must check in at the Member Check-in, have their temperature taken, and complete the health screening.
- Please do not come on the deck for practice until the previous swimmers are off the deck and the housekeeping team has sanitized. The staff will let you know when to enter.
- All Swimmers need to clear off the deck and out of the pool area by :50 minute mark. No congregating or hanging out on the pool deck before or after practice.
- Parents may be on deck. Please drop off and pick up your child. Parents may not sit on deck and congregate at the tables. Parents will wear a mask at all times while on campus. (This is a directive from the Santa Clara County Department of Public Health)
- Swimmers may not use the locker rooms, they are for restroom purposes only. Please come changed and leave in swimsuits. No changing on deck or in the restrooms. (This is a directive from the Santa Clara County Department of Public Health)
- Swimmers will be 2-3 to a lane and will maintain social distancing.
- The same group will be practicing all month together. No mid-month add-on or changing of days. (This is a directive from the Santa Clara County Department of Public Health)
- Maximum number per team is 12.

Family Responsibilities:

- We are all in the Covid-19 fight together and we believe that we can all do our part to keep our community safe.
- Parents will adhere to sick child policies and other protocols.
- Families will continue to shelter in place, to the best of their ability, and follow face covering and physical distancing directives when out in public.
- **Children will not attend other group programs while they are attending Swim Team (this is a directive from the Santa Clara County Department of Public Health).**
- Parents will make sure children are not displaying possible symptoms of Covid-19 when they are dropped off at the JCC.
- Parents will not bring a child to the JCC when anyone in their household has possible symptoms of Covid-19.
- Parents agree to keep their child home for two weeks, after a trip, if the child has flown in an airplane.
- Parents will consider, understand and acknowledge that every decision they make for their family in terms of safety has the potential to affect every family on their child's team.
